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MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

New Membership Application Form

AIMS:

To promote the science, knowledge, construction and demonstration of engineering models of all kinds.

MEMBERSHIP:

Any person over the age of 18 years is entitled to apply for Senior Membership. Junior Members are admitted from the age of 10 years. All senior financial members have the right to vote.

OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP:

Members are required to support the Society on Open Days. During the first 3 months of membership, a new member is required to attend ONE Open Day and ONE preparation day. Members are also required to assist in open days and clean up days where ever possible. Membership may be revoked for failure to comply with these conditions.

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP:

All applications for membership must be made on the official Application Form. The Application Form must be supported by the nomination of a member, endorsed by the Section Leader of the section that has been nominated as the Primary Interest, accompanied by the Application Fee, the Annual Subscription as listed and a signed Child Protection Form (Child Protection Act 1998).

SUBSCRIPTIONS:

Annual Subscriptions are due on June 1st and should be paid before June 30th to retain membership. Unless a member notifies his/her intention to resign his/her membership, in writing, to the Secretary, before June 30th, he/she shall be liable for the Annual Subscription for the following year. Any member not financial after June 30th may be expelled from the Society in accordance with the Rules of the Society. Such a member may incur a further Application Fee if he/she wishes to resume membership.

MEETINGS:

Monthly meetings are held by the Board throughout the year and are held on the 2nd Tuesday of the month in the Clubhouse at 869 Luddenham Road, Luddenham, commencing at 7:00pm. Each Section has their own Board member who is expected to attend these meetings on behalf of their Section.

PREPARATION DAYS:

These are held on the Sunday prior to Open Days or whatever days the section organises. To ensure the continued operation of the Society, all members are REQUESTED to participate. NO modelling is allowed before the work is completed.

RUNNING DAYS:

"Model Park" is open to the public on the last Sunday of each month, except December. The collection of Entrance Fees, from the public, is vital for the continued operation, maintenance and expansion of the facilities for members and the public. The facilities of the Society are available to members 365 days of the year.

KEYS/CARDS:

Each member is entitled to a front gate key and Swipe card. The gate MUST be left locked at all times upon entering and leaving. Any member who lends cards/keys to non-members, to enable the non-member use of the Societies facilities, without the member being present, may be expelled from the Society. If a key/card is lost the member must notify the membership officer and will incur a fee of \$20.00 for replacement of each item.

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MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

SSME Inc. PROHIBITED EMPLOYMENT DECLARATION

The *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998* makes it an offence for a prohibited person (a person convicted of a serious sex offence, the murder of a child or a child-related personal violence offence, as well as a Registrable person under the *Child Protection (Offenders Registration) Act 2000*) to apply for or otherwise attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in, child-related employment. It does not apply if an order from the Industrial Relations Commission, Administrative Decisions Tribunal or Commission for Children and Young People, declares that the Act does not apply to a person in respect of a specific offence.

For further information on what is child-related employment, see the *Working With Children Employers Guidelines* on www.kids.nsw.gov.au.

Section 33B of the *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998* defines a serious sex offence as:

- an offence involving sexual activity or acts of indecency committed in New South Wales and that was punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more; or
- an offence involving sexual activity or acts of indecency committed elsewhere and that would have been an offence punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more, if it had been committed in New South Wales; or
- an offence under section 80D or 80E (sexual servitude) of the *Crimes Act 1900*, committed against a child; or
- an offence under Sections 91D-91G (child prostitution, other than if committed by a child prostitute) of the *Crimes Act 1900* or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales; or
- an offence under Section 91H, 578B or 578C (2A) (child pornography) of the *Crimes Act 1900* or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales; or
- an offence of attempting, or of conspiracy or incitement, to commit an offence referred to in the preceding paragraphs; or
- any other offence, whether under the law of New South Wales or elsewhere, prescribed by the regulations.

Note: A conviction for carnal knowledge is classified as a serious sex offence under this legislation.

Section 33B of the *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998* defines a child-related personal violence offence as an offence committed by an adult:

- involving intentionally wounding or causing grievous bodily harm to a child; or
- of attempting, or of conspiracy or incitement, to commit such an offence.

Under *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998*:

- it is an offence for a Prohibited Person to **apply for, or otherwise attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in** child related employment;
- employers **must** ask existing employees, both **paid** and **unpaid**, and preferred applicants for child-related employment to declare if they are a Prohibited Person or not;
